

# Annual Student Activities Meeting

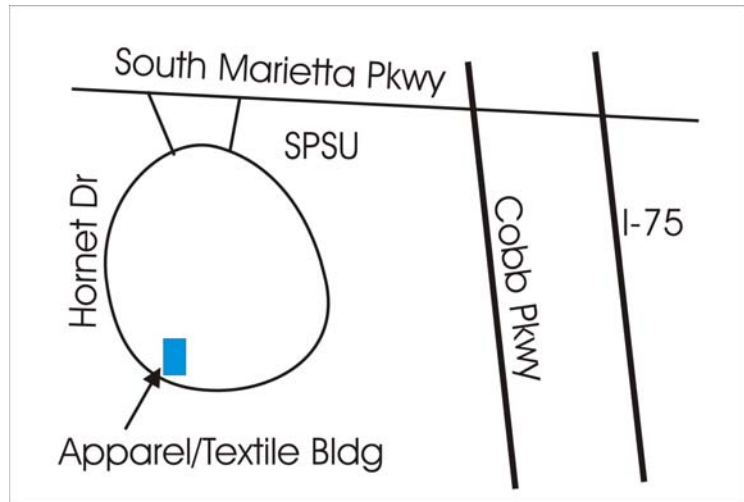
## Monday, April 19th
