



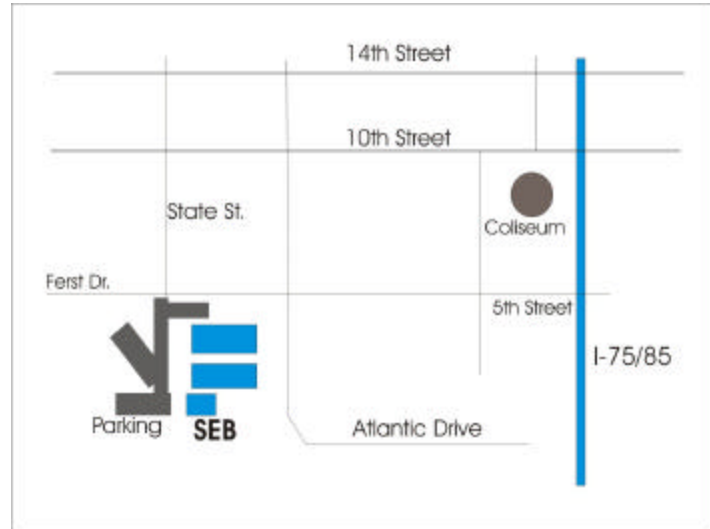
Atlanta Section Meeting Notice State of the Automotive Industry in Georgia Monday, February 16th
